References List format according to the APA style (7th ed).

The word **References** should appear in bold in title case and be centred at the top of the page.

In the text. The in-text citation consists of author surname(s)/family name(s), in the order that they appear on the actual publication, followed by the year of publication of the source that you are citing.

- For direct quotes, make sure to include page or paragraph number. eg. (Weston, 1988, p. 45).
- The in-text citation is placed immediately after the information being cited.
- If your citation is at the end of a sentence, ensure the full stop is placed after the reference.

Tables, pictures, and other non-text objects shall be placed in the middle of the text. They must be numbered and named/ annotated. The pictures shall be named/ annotated in the center under the picture (Picture 1. **Name**); table's number shall be above it, the right alignment (Table 1), table's name shall be above it in the center, bold.
